Jr. High Campers!

We have received your camp registration and we are looking forward to seeing you at Sky Ranch on June 30! The days we spend are sure to be filled with unforgettable experiences!



Our theme this year is "The Missing Peace" based on 1 Peter 3:15. Kyle Goings, Youth Pastor at First MB Church in Wichita will be our speaker. Our worship will be led by Jake Stemo and his band from Wichita. They led worship for Jr High Camp the last 3 years.

Aaron and Jess Schmucker and Carly Wilhelm will be our Program Directors. They will arrange the activities and games throughout the week and have a bunch of great games/activities awaiting you! The Jr High Camp staff is looking forward to camp and have a great week planned for you!

Here's some important stuff you need to know!

Registration Check-in is on Saturday, June 30th from 3:00 - 4:00 pm in Katie Hall.

Medications Please bring any medication to the registration table when you get to camp. Medications will be kept at the Nurse's Station if you requested this on your medical form or the nurse feels it is necessary for her to keep it. These campers will go to the nurse's table in the Dining Hall at mealtime to get their medication. **PARENTS:** if you have special medical instructions, please send that info along with your child to camp. Also, a copy of your Medical Insurance Card would be of great help if your camper should need to see a doctor during camp. Please turn these copies in to the nurse at registration if you didn't attach them to your registration.

Free-time Activities Campers will be participating in a variety of activities while at camp. The following activities are free and are available during free-time: Gaga ball, volleyball, tetherball, basketball, human foosball, soccer, low ropes, riverfront (swimming, blob, zipline, slide, kayaking, etc.) and the Skyde (water slide). Also every student will have the opportunity to ride the "Edge" zipline (Oklahoma's largest zipline - 2300 feet long) once free of charge during the free-time activities.

Free-time Tournaments. This year we will be setting up tournaments during free time and will be competing against each other. We will have a 3 v 3 basketball tournament, a dodgeball tournament, and a sand volleyball tournament. Get some people together and form a team and have some fun!

Extra Cost Afternoon Activities You will have an opportunity to sign-up and pay for extra cost activities when you're at camp. These activities will be offered during afternoon free time and are one hour each. The prices are:

Skeet Shooting \$6.25, Outdoor Laser Tag \$11.50, Horseback Riding \$16.50, and Frontier Zone \$6.25. Payment for these activities can be made at the Wagon Wheel store by cash or check made to "Sky Ranch".


Notes: 1) Horseback riding requires long pants and covered shoes.
2) Frontier Zone consists of Archery, BB Guns, Hatchet Throwing and slingshot.

Appropriate Dress: Girls - Modest one-piece swimming suits or appropriate "tankini's" are required. No bikinis are allowed. If a counselor or staff member feels your swimming attire is inappropriate you will be asked to wear a t-shirt over your bathing suit. **Guys** - shirts are required around camp unless you are swimming. **Everyone** - all guests must wear shoes or sandals, a shirt, and dry clothes in the Dining Hall. **Please dress modestly and honor God with your dress this week!**

Please bring your Bible, pen/pencil, pillow, blanket or sleeping bag, personal items (towels, soap, toothbrush, etc.), camera, swimsuit, flashlight, bug repellent, set of clothes and shoes/sandals you can get wet/dirty, fishing equipment if you want to fish in the creek, and spending money. Speaking of spending money, the "Wagon Wheel" camp store will be open daily from 8 am to 8 pm. Don't bring your life savings, but a few dollars for pop, candy, Sky Ranch t-shirts, etc., might be helpful. **Please Note:** We are not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged items.

Cell Phones It is recommended that a student does not bring a cell phone to camp. If a student brings a cell phone, we ask that they keep it in their cabins and not use them throughout the week. We want to avoid distractions and focus on God this week. If campers are found to be using their cell phones unnecessarily, counselors and staff will ask them to put their phones away. If it happens repeatedly, phones may be confiscated until the end of camp and a notification will be sent to the parents.

Camp will conclude on Wednesday, July 4, after our morning session. Whoever is picking you up should be at camp by 11:00 am.
